Location: 1258 Old Route 119 South, Mount Pleasant, PA 15666

Target Opening Date: June, 2008

Capabilities:

- Connections to CSX, Norfolk Southern, and CN with daily service from Southwest Pennsylvania Railroad
- 180,000 gallon/day ethanol transloading capability
- 145 railcar capacity on private siding capable of storing over 4 million gallons
- 40 miles southeast of Pittsburgh; 90 mi from Altoona, PA; 80 mi from Wheeling, WV; and 80 from Steubenville, OH
- 30 transloading spots, all with spill collection
- Alcohol Resistant AFFF Foam fire suppression system
- Ethanol transloading system (RBT's PE400)
 - 400 gpm-rated pump
 - Scully ground verification and overfill protection
 - Vapor recovery system
 - 4" suction and discharge hoses
 - Temperature-compensated meter certified-for-trade
 - Truck scale certified-for-trade
